Submit student and faculty work to compete for our four GET Prizes. Four prizes, each of \$350, will be awarded: two for students, and two for faculty.

### CATEGORIES FOR THE 2022-23 GET PRIZE

#### Student Prizes

Global Expression

and Thought

Student submissions are written work that involve cross-cultural examination and/or reflection in one of the following categories:

<u>GLOBAL DISCOVERY ENTRY</u>: a personal reflection on an experience of intercultural resonance. These pieces would describe how an experience of local, national, and/or global interconnection impacted the student's worldview and sense of self and place.

<u>GLOBAL THOUGHT PIECE</u>: an analytical and/or persuasive piece on a topic of international significance. These pieces would articulate thoughtful analysis and/or to defend a particular stance on a topic/issue of local, national, or global significance.

Written pieces should not exceed 750 words. Each prize is awarded to an individual student.

### Faculty Prizes

Faculty submissions are lessons/units/projects that educate for global competence. *Additional details can be found at gebg.org.* 



The due date for GET Prize submissions is **March 6, 2023**. GET Prize entries are to be submitted by the school's Global Coordinator on behalf of the student or educator, with no more than 2 entries per division.
