It is recommended to choose to spend the day in either **Tivoli Gardens** or at **Bakken**, as it is a whole-day experience. Both parks offer a unique glimpse into Denmark's long-standing tradition of adventure and entertainment, each with its own distinct vibe. Both parks also serve as great places to experience Danish culture and history while having fun.

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## **Tivoli Gardens (Copenhagen)**

*Tivoli Gardens, located in the heart of Copenhagen, is one of the oldest amusement parks in the world, opening its doors in 1843. It's a mix of thrilling rides, beautiful gardens, live performances, and historic architecture, making it a must-see destination. The park is especially magical at night when it lights up with thousands of colorful lights. Some highlights include the famous wooden roller coaster, "Den gamle Rutschebane," and various cultural events like concerts and ballet performances (these are not included in the entrance price). Tivoli has inspired many other theme parks worldwide, including Disneyland.*

## **Bakken (Klampenborg)**

*Bakken, located just outside Copenhagen, is even older than Tivoli, opening in 1583. It holds the title of the world's oldest operating amusement park. Despite its age, it remains incredibly charming, with classic rides like the "Scenic Railway" (another historic wooden roller coaster) and various carnival-style attractions. Its laid-back, nostalgic atmosphere contrasts with Tivoli's more polished, modern look. Surrounded by forests and close to the coast, Bakken is a great spot for a more relaxed day out, where visitors can also enjoy the natural beauty of the area.*

- Tickets: maximum approx. \$50 USD pr. person.
- Food: approx. \$30-75 USD pr. person
