



ENTER TO WIN OUR GLOBAL EDUCATION AWARD

GLOBAL EXPRESSION AND THOUGHT (GET) PRIZE

Submit student work to compete for the primary, middle, or high school GET Prize awards. One prize of \$333 will be awarded at each of the three levels.

CATEGORIES FOR THE 2018 GET PRIZE

Primary Level (Grades 1-4)

A student-driven, global classroom activity or unit that involves two or more cultures. The prize will be awarded to a teacher.

Middle Level (Grades 5-8) and High School Level (Grades 9-12)

Student work involving cross-cultural perspectives and reflection in one of the following categories:

GLOBAL DISCOVERY ENTRY: e.g., a comparison of sports, fashion, food; or travel writing, or service reflections.

GLOBAL THOUGHT PIECE: e.g., a MUN policy essay, a letter to a local newspaper, a comparative literary essay that reflects on two global works; a piece that documents aspects of the immigration experience.

Written pieces should not exceed 750 words. Each prize is awarded to an individual student.



The due date for GET Prize submissions is December 1, 2018. GET Prize entries are to be submitted by the school's Global coordinator on behalf of the student or educator with no more than 2 entries per division.
